Position Announcement: Peace Officer

The Windsor Heights Police Department is accepting applications for the position of Peace Officer to fill one fulltime vacancy. Minimally qualified applicants must be 21 years of age, of good moral character, not addicted to drugs or alcohol, have never been convicted of a felony, possess a high school diploma or G.E.D., have 20/100 eyesight which is correctable to 20/20, normal color and field of vision, and normal hearing; ILEA certified (or equivalent out of state certification with three years law enforcement experience AND currently active) candidates will be given preference. Non-certified candidates start at \$40,231 annually; certified peace officers begin at \$44,987 with excellent benefits package, paid time off (PTO), and enrollment in the IPERS retirement system.

The Department is also recruiting part-time certified peace officers to fill two positions within its weekend ASAP unit (Alcohol Safety Action Program). The program targets impaired drivers on Friday and Saturday nights. Part-time officers will be fully commissioned by the City of Windsor Heights.
